Expanding Visitor Access – A Phased Approach

Dear patient and family members,

Manitoba's high vaccine uptake and the decreasing level of transmission of the virus in our community are allowing for a phased loosening of visitor restrictions.

Within our facility, and across Manitoba, COVID-19 remains a significant area of focus and operational priority. We continue to take every preventative measure to reduce the risk of the virus to our patients, many of whom have pre-existing health conditions that put them at greater risk for severe illness.

We are very pleased to see the provincial situation stabilizing and look forward to once again welcoming family and friends. **Effective Wednesday, February 23, 2022, visitor access will gradually expand**, and this is what it means for you:

- You may identify **up to two Fully Vaccinated General Visitors** (*Fully vaccinated is an individual who has received both doses of the COVID-19 vaccine, with second dose received more than 14 days ago*).
- A maximum of one visitor will be permitted in the room at one time. We may approve an additional visitor where space permits and at the discretion of the care team.
- Visits must occur during visiting hours and do not include “come and go” access.
- Exceptions may be made on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of the care team.
- Based at the discretion of the care team, we may be unable to facilitate visits for certain patients.

Please ensure your visitors are informed of the following requirements:

- Visits must occur during visiting hours: 8:30 a.m. and 8:30 p.m.
- All visitors must show proof of vaccination status each time they enter and must follow all requirements: use of medical masks, hand hygiene, physical distancing, and enhanced cleaning/disinfection.
