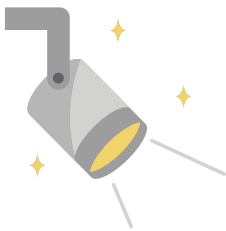


Take our kids to work day 2023

Answer Questions

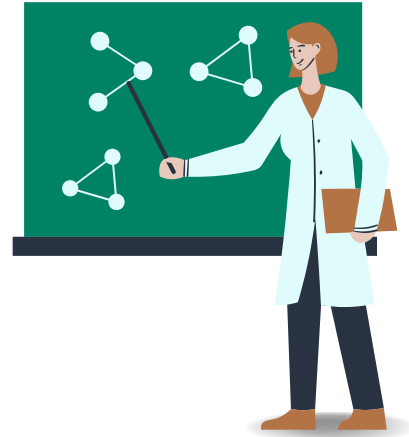
By prompting the staff in each area to answer these questions:

- What is the average starting salary for someone who does this job?
- What is your favourite part of the job?

HOW TO MAKE THE TIME MORE VALUABLE

Explain that HSC Winnipeg is a teaching hospital

one of only two in Manitoba (the other is St. Boniface General Hospital). This means that for certain healthcare jobs, part of their training might take place here at HSC. It is also one reason why the University of Manitoba has a satellite campus.



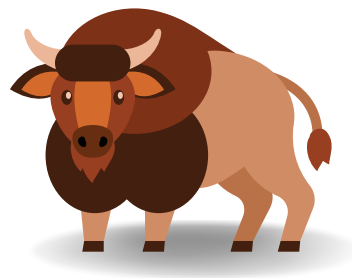
Talk about Volunteering at HSC
